

INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE USE OF THE SUTTON ROAD DRIVER TRAINING COMPLEX FACILITIES

The following instructions are provided for the information of all hirers in accordance with clause 6.1(d) of the Sutton Road Complex hiring agreement. Sutton Road Driver Training complex is **NOT** a race track. It is a purpose built driver training complex for promoting safe driving practices through appropriate training activities. Any form of racing is expressly forbidden within the complex at any time.

GENERAL

- All vehicles used at the complex **MUST** be road worthy and have current state and/or territory public road use registration.
- All motor vehicles used in any activity **MUST NOT** be excessively noisy. Any vehicle that appears to breach this rule must leave the complex or be withdrawn from all activities immediately.
- Any form of tyre “burnout” or unnecessarily excessive wheel spin is expressly prohibited.
- The hirer **MUST** undertake a drivers briefing regarding these requirements prior to conducting any driving activities.
- Anyone acting in an unsafe or inappropriate manner will be directed to leave the complex.
- Approved seat belts and/or safety harnesses are to be worn at all times by all occupants of a vehicle while using any facilities within the complex.
- All activities conducted within the complex are to be individually supervised.
- Refueling of vehicles within the complex is prohibited unless conducted in specific areas approved by The Council in advance of the event.
- All hirers and members of the public are subject to Drug & Alcohol testing whilst using the complex facilities as/if required

SKID PAN

- **WATER ONLY** is to be placed on the skid pan surface using the installed watering system. Under no circumstances are any oils, detergents or any other substances to be used or placed upon or in close proximity to the skid pan.
- Excessive speed on the skid pan is to be avoided.
- Driving on the grass surround of the skid pan is strictly prohibited.

- Unless expressly authorised, only one vehicle at a time at a time is permitted to operate on the skid pan.

TRAINING TRACK

- No racing or close driving between vehicles.
- Where more than one vehicle is using the track, ALL vehicles must circulate around the track in the same direction.
- Heavy brake testing must only be conducted on the designated areas of the main straight.
- Under no circumstances are any oils, detergents or any other substances to be used or placed upon or in close proximity to the track.
- When using the training track, vehicles **MUST NOT** leave the bitumen surface for any reason. Gravel and dirt kicked up onto the track can become dangerous for other vehicles using the facility. Where the track has to be cleaned following a hire, The person or group hiring the facility will be responsible for all cleaning and rectification costs.

VEHICLE MANEUVRING AREA

- Excessive speed is to be avoided.
- Excessive wheel spin and/or sever braking is to be avoided.
